SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum (PM) 2003-01; Wear of Honor Guard Accouterments

1. In accordance with the February 2000 National Board Meeting, certain items have been approved for wear by cadets during Color Guard and Honor Guard performances. Furthermore, the following uniform items are authorized for wear by NEWG Cadets, male and female, while participating in Honor Guard or Color Guard activities:
  - Male service cap with cadet officer hat device and rear chinstrap
  - White gloves, belt, ascot and leggings.
  - White or silver shoulder cord.
2. Honor Guard performances include Color Guards (cadet enlisted grades only), Drill Cordons, Proffering, POW/MIA Ceremonies, VIP Escort, and those ceremonies authorized by the Wing Commander or Wing Director of Cadet Programs only.
3. These items will only be worn while performing Honor Guard or Color Guard duties and these uniform items are not authorized for wear at the Cadet Competition. The uniform prescribed for the competition will be provided in the rules of engagement.
4. No other changes to the uniform are authorized.
