4. Cadet Commander
  - Must be a member of the unit.
  - Must have served as a flight commander at a unit or encampment.
  - Should have completed all requirements for phase two, the nco phase of the cadet program.
  - Be willing to devote time and energy to the cadet corps and take full responsibility for both there actions and the actions of those bellow them in the chain of command.
  - Be willing to work with senior staff
  - Reports directly to Deputy Commander for Cadets
